

**Minutes of the Potrero Boosters General Membership Meeting  
Held July 28, 2020 by Teleconference**

- JR Eppler, president of the Boosters, called the meeting to order at 7:02 and provided a Zoom refresher.
- Minutes from the 6/30/20 meeting were approved by voice vote.
- We had an update on neighborhood schools: There is still uncertainty about the re-opening of Daniel Webster but Friends of Potrero Preschool is underway.
- The Executive Committee provided a recap on Slow Streets, Shared Spaces and Parking. Keith Goldstein updated us on the Shared Spaces program, which is vital to the survival of some of our neighborhood businesses. He asked that any complaints be directed to him at [info@potrerodogpatch.com](mailto:info@potrerodogpatch.com). JR noted additions to the Slow Streets program including 20<sup>th</sup> Street, Arkansas, Minnesota, and an additional block on Mariposa. The Potrero Parking plans for NE and NW have been approved.
- We welcomed a panel of our neighbors from the Bayview that included Kirk Davis (Kairos San Francisco) Anietie Ekanem (One Bayview) and Earl Shaddix (Economic Development on Third). We learned how the community is coming together during the pandemic and dealing with the impacts of gentrification and displacement, health issues, and hostility to BLM. The panel was optimistic that the right people are in the room now and that there are glimmers of hope. - The membership was asked to ratify a letter signed by the Executive Committee calling for equitable allocation of social services throughout the City, with navigation centers in all districts. The motion was made and ratified by voice vote.
